2023 WAYNE POLICE SURVEY SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT FINDINGS

A most sincere thank you to everyone who participated in the Village of Wayne / Police Department Village-wide survey. There were 294 participants in the survey. The purpose of the survey was to provide Village Officials and the Police Department Command Staff with meaningful feedback from our residents regarding the value they place on various police services, and to help establish the priorities of police resources. We are very pleased with the results of the survey. We will be further analyzing the data and plan to incorporate the information gleaned as we move forward.

The following summary of information represents the highlights (<u>top responses</u>) for each question of the survey. The results were just received, and a more complete picture of the results will be forthcoming once the most optimal format is determined. (March 6, 2023)

1. Who was the average responder?

- 64% reside in DuPage County; 36% reside in Kane County.
- 43% have lived in Wayne for 20+ years; 29% from 2-10 years.
- 66% of the respondents are over 55 years old.
- 82% of respondents reside with their spouse/parent.
- 21% of respondents have children under 18 residing in the home.

2. Social Media?

- 66% of the respondents have social media.
- 66% do follow the Wayne IL Police Department Facebook page.
- 3. How often do you feel safe and secure in your neighborhood?
 - 93% of the respondents always or very often feel safe and secure in their neighborhood (52% always, 41% very often).
- 4. What are the top (3) three priorities for the Police Department?
 - Public Safety/Crime Prevention 70%
 - Residential/Vehicle Burglaries 54%

 - 64% of the respondents did have interaction with a member of the Police Department.
 - 92% of the respondents indicated the member was respectful, helpful, and clear in explaining their actions.
- 7. How satisfied are you with overall performance provided by the Wayne Police Department as a whole?
 - 96% of the respondents feel very satisfied, satisfied, or somewhat satisfied with the performance by the Wayne Police Department (59% of respondents feel very satisfied; 28% feel satisfied; 9% somewhat satisfied).
